






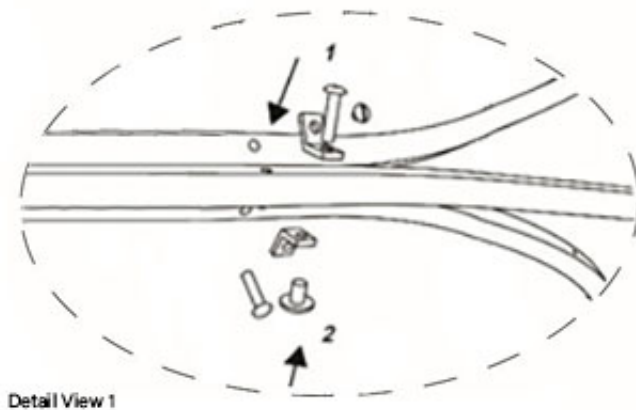

Assembly Level: Intermediate  
Tools Required: Slotted & Phillips Screwdriver

Step 1: Choose where the birdbath will be placed and push the installation stake into the soil. It is important to **NOT** use a hammer directly on the stake as it will damage the area that the legs slide onto. We suggest using a rubber mallet or placing a piece of wood over the top of the stake first.

Step 2: Make sure the installation stake (**B**) is level.

Step 3: As shown in detail view 1, find a flat surface to lay the legs on horizontally, then attach one montage piece (**E**) using its montage screw (**F**). Once the montage piece is securely in place, repeat the process with the next leg. (The longer barrel nut should pass through one montage piece, then through the leg, and finally through another montage piece before tightening the smaller screw)



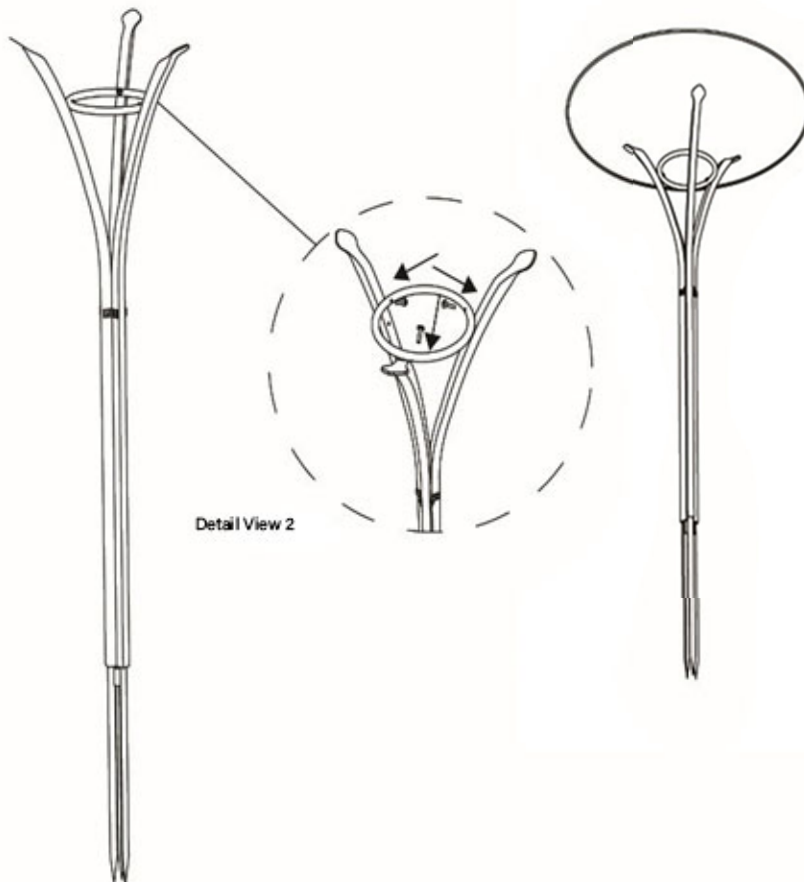

Step 3: After all the legs are held together with their montage pieces (E) and screws (F) slip the open end over the exposed stakes that you drove into the ground earlier.

Step 5: As shown in detail view 2, place the circle (C) in the center and fix screws (D). It is important to note that these screws are slightly angled.

Step 6: Set the birdbath on the 3-pronged stand and admire your work.
