
## Assembly & Care Information for our Handspun



Our handcrafted Copper Birdbaths are made by hand-spinning copper on a metal spinning lathe. The technique of spinning metal was first developed by the ancient Egyptians some 3,000 to 4,000 years ago. A flat disc of copper is held with a tool by the spinner against a fulcrum for support to shape the metal. The principle is similar to a potter shaping clay on a wheel.

Copper is a wonderful metal. It does not crack, rust or corrode. It will literally last forever and become more and more beautiful with age.

Mineral deposits from the minerals in water occur naturally on the Copper Bowls. These can be removed with baking soda and vinegar paste solution and a soft cloth or sponge. It is also possible to purchase a natural enzyme solution from a birding store that is bird/wildlife safe that eliminates mineral deposits.

All our copper bowls come waxed and may be re-waxed for maintenance. We recommend Carnauba, also called Brazil wax and palm wax, as it is a natural wax that will not harm your birds.

We highly recommend putting small rocks in your birdbath for the birds to land on. It creates a pond-like setting, which the birds love.
